

Republic of Texas History Center Naming Opportunities

Republic of Texas History Center: \$2,000,000

The Republic of Texas History Center will be the permanent home to the Republic of Texas Museum and Daughters of the Republic of Texas Headquarters.

Republic of Texas Museum: \$1,000,000

Previously located in North Austin, the new home of the Republic of Texas Museum will provide children and families with the experience of becoming a Texan in the early 1800s.

House of the Daughters: (Reserved by a Donor)

The House will serve as the headquarters for all Daughters of the Republic activities and will be the home for a multipurpose room, Family Research Center, staff offices, and the archives and documentation area.

Republic Pavilion: \$500,000

The new space will provide a beautiful indoor area for weddings and special events. The new pavilion will have access to the many wonderful features located throughout the Republic of Texas History Center including a kitchen.

Gallery of Heroes: \$250,000

Visitors to the Republic of Texas Museum will be amazed at the historical artifacts collected from the heroes of the Republic of Texas, including personal effects of Sam Houston, Stephen F. Austin, and General Santa Anna.

Republic Courtyard & Water Feature: \$250,000

The Courtyard and water feature will be a welcome spot for visitors to reflect on the history of the early Texas settlers.

Texas Children's Interactive Learning: \$100,000

This area will be a favorite of our youngest visitors. It will include hands-on exhibits allowing children to dress in period clothing and to better understand the currency of the Republic and food exhibitions.

Museum Store/Gift Shop: (Reserved by a Donor)

Designed to provide visitors to the Republic of Texas Center with something to purchase that will be a memory of their experience at the Center and French Legation Museum.

Museum Front Porch: \$100,000

This striking front porch will provide a warm Texas welcome as well as offer the perfect place to take in the natural beauty of the Republic of Texas History Center.

Family Research Center: (Reserved by a Donor)

The Daughters of the Republic of Texas pride themselves on assisting visitors interested in researching their Texas roots.

Kitchen: \$100,000

The kitchen, located off the Pavilion, will provide caterers with an area where final food preparations can be made before serving guests attending a meeting or social event.

DRT Seal Windows: \$75,000 Each

On each side of the third floor will be a round window representing the seal of The Daughters of the Republic of Texas. See 3rd floor of building below.

Museum Exhibit Areas: \$50,000 Each (Only 2 Remaining)

The Republic of Texas Museum will immerse visitors in the time period as they walk through exhibits, including a Texas Pioneer Life, Cultures of Texas, and more.

Multipurpose Room: (Reserved by a Donor)

The Daughters' Multipurpose Room will be the frequent site for DRT gatherings and will also be utilized by the public for meetings, events, and weddings.

Republic of Texas Archives & Documentation: \$50,000

The archives area, third floor, will hold artifacts from the Republic of Texas period as they are stored, restored, and made ready for display within the Republic of Texas Museum.

Wall of Honor: \$5,000 and Above

All donors of \$5,000 and above will be listed on a special wall of honor located in the Gallery of Heroes.



The Daughters of the Republic of Texas (DRT) own the property adjacent to the French Legation Museum. By building the Republic of Texas Museum and business offices on this property, DRT will create the ***Republic of Texas History Center*** and a visit to three museums: Republic of Texas Museum, Children's Interactive Museum, and French Legation Museum.

The Center will provide a larger, more appropriate setting for exhibits, educational programs, conferences, and other festivities. In this way, DRT will better serve the State and visitors seeking to learn about the fascinating history of the ***State of Texas***.
