

# DRT Logo Design Contest

## Additional Information for District Reps

- Please discuss the DRT Logo Design Contest at your District Workshop and encourage your chapters to participate. The President General really wants this to be a grass-roots effort.
- Print out copies of the Contest Submission Information to pass out to District Workshop attendees.
- Follow up by emailing the Contest Submission Information document to all your Chapter Presidents.

## Timeline

- **July 2017:** Logo Design Committee distributes Contest Submission Information document and guidelines to the District Reps. Also arranges for information to be posted on DRT members only website.
- **August-October 2017:** District Reps present information about contest at District Workshops and follow up with Chapter Presidents. Logo Design Committee will work with Custodian General to ensure that Members at Large (MAL) are contacted.
- **January 15, 2018:** All submissions are due to District Reps. Members at Large will submit directly to Committee.
- **February 1, 2018:** District Reps send all logo submissions to Logo Design Contest Committee **NO LATER THAN Feb 1.** Email Tiffany Miller ([Tiffany.A.Miller@att.net](mailto:Tiffany.A.Miller@att.net) or [District9Rep@drinfo.org](mailto:District9Rep@drinfo.org))
- **February 2018:** Each submission will be assigned a letter (A-Z) by the Committee, so that the designer's name and district affiliation will remain anonymous during voting. Submissions will then be printed out for display for the February 2018 BOM Meeting.
- **February 2018 BOM Meeting:** The Logo Design Contest Committee will present the submissions to the BOM and the BOM will choose up to four designs to be presented at the May 2018 Convention.
- **March 2018:** The Designers of the chosen designs will be notified by their District Rep or a member of the Logo Design Committee. The General Membership will be notified of the chosen designs and that a vote will occur on the designs at the May 2018 Convention.
- **May 2018 Convention:** General Membership votes on Logo Design.
- **May/June 2018:** Winner will be notified and given instructions on how one year Dues Exemption will be handled.
