THE LIFE AND TIMES OF JOSÉ ANTONIO NAVARRO



As one of the signers of the Texas Declaration of Independence, and later the Constitution of the Republic of Texas, the native born José Antonio Navarro was truly a Texas statesman. As society and the world changed around him, José Antonio Navarro proved his courage and his resilience by adapting to the needs of the times. He never, however, let go of his pride and his love of his Hispanic culture. He is a man we should emulate today.

Dr. Carolina Castillo Crimm was born and raised in Mexico City. She holds degrees from the University of Miami, Texas Tech and a Ph.D. in Latin American History from The University of Texas at Austin. Among her many books and articles is the award-winning *De León: A Tejano*

Family History. After 40 years of teaching, she has recently retired and been honored as a Professor Emeritus from Sam Houston State University. She lives in Huntsville, Texas with her husband, Jack and has just started a new company, Historic Tours of Texas.

Casa Navarro State Historic Site is situated in the heart of old San Antonio, in what used to be a thriving Tejano neighborhood known as Laredito. Visitors can experience José Antonio Navarro's original one-story, white-washed adobe and limestone house and explore his historical contributions, stories, and legacies through new, multi-sensory and hands-on exhibits. As one of the oldest structures in San Antonio, Casa Navarro explores the legacy of Tejanos and the Laredito neighborhood through new research through food, photographs, urban renewal and renovation of the site.
